Alhaji Mudariss Isiaq Adewole Adisa Kareem's life embodied a remarkable blend of spiritual leadership, creative talent, and resilience in the face of adversity.

Born to Chief Imam Al Khalifah A K Bello and Aasiya A K Bello (May Allah SWT have mercy on their Souls) on the 28th of August 1944, he entered the world surrounded by a family deeply entrenched in faith and community service.

Tragically, his early years were shadowed by the profound loss of his mother. Her's passing, at a tender age of 24 years old, left Isiaq bereft at just around 2 years old, alongside his younger sister, who was merely months old at the time. The void left by his mother's absence was immense, yet Isiaq's journey was guided by the enduring love, wisdom and teachings of his father and maternal grandfather.

Surrounded by the pillars of faith and family, Alhaj Mudariss character was forged with resilience, compassion, humour and a deep sense of purpose, his father's role as a Chief Imam, scholar, missionary and a visionary community leader provided a strong foundation of spirituality and community service, that guided his path.

As he navigated through the challenges of growing up without a mother, his resilience and determination became apparent. He found solace in his faith and the support of his family, especially his father eventually channelling his talents and passions into the field of draughtsmanship.

Alhaj Mudariss journey as a draughtsman working at Mandilas allowed him to blend his creativity with technical skill, leaving a lasting impact on the architectural landscape amongst which was the River State University of Science and Technology construction project - This project took away from the comfort of his home and environment in Lagos to Port Harcourt for over 4 years. Despite the hardships he faced early in life, Alhaj Mudariss emerged as a shining example of perseverance, embodying the values of compassion, integrity, and dedication instilled by his father.

Through his roles as a Chief Imam, Chief Missioner, and draughtsman, he inspired others with his unwavering commitment to faith, family, community, and excellence. His story serves as a reminder that even in the face of adversity, resilience and determination can lead to remarkable achievements and a life of purpose.

He departed this world at the age of 76 years leaving behind wives, children, grandchildren, a lifetime of service and a profound impact on all who knew him
